Board Meeting Minutes November 21, 2019 Carter Park 9030 Asheville Highway

1. Welcome

Cindy Pionke, Strategic Facilities Engineer/ADA 504 Coordinator for Knox County, called the meeting to order at 3:10 p.m. She recognized and thanked DAGWould? members who were present for the meeting: Tim Adams, Anna Bass, Nancy Brown, Stanley Taylor, and Shazi Ahmad.

- 2. Approval of October Minutes
 Minutes from the October meeting were approved.
- 3. Tour of Carter Park led by Shauna Godlevsky, Parks Planning and Development Manager for Knox County
 - a. Areas toured
 - i. Soccer field, its bleachers, and nearby restrooms
 - ii. Baseball field, its bleachers, and concession area
 - iii. Covered picnic area
 - iv. Playground

b. Findings

- i. Soccer field
 - 1. To access the soccer field and bleacher area, one must go through the lawn and stay off the sidewalk-as there are no sidewalk cutouts.
 - 2. The sidewalk surrounding the restrooms do not connect all around the building-as it cuts off just before you approach the women's restroom. If you approach from the other side, access is blocked by a large A/C unit in the middle of the sidewalk, making it impossible for a wheelchair and/or walker user to get to the restroom.

ii. Baseball Field

- 1. The ramps going down to the baseball field and bleacher area have a steep incline and drop off on one side.
- 2. There is not an open area for someone in a wheelchair to sit next to the bleachers.
- 3. Access to the concession area is difficult due to the steep incline leading up to the area.

iii. Covered Picnic Area

- 1. Access to this area is very difficult due to the long, steep incline leading up to it.
- 2. Once at the top, the picnic tables and their configuration are not accessible.
 - a. No access for a wheelchair to pull up to a table.
 - b. Not enough room for a wheelchair or walker to navigate past the first picnic table-as they are too close together and too heavy to move.

iv. Playground

- 1. There is no access to this area unless one tries to go through the uneven, grassy area leading up to it.
- 4. Set Next Meeting Location
