Mayor Jacobs Talks About Men of Valor, Advance Knox, and More

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.— During his Weekly Update, which will post around 12 p.m. today, Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs talks about the Men of Valor prison reentry ministry, addresses the Land Use Comprehensive Plan, and invites the public to attend April's Eat and Greet.

Mayor Jacobs was honored to speak at this year's Men of Valor Breakfast. He also spent the morning listening to the testimonies of several men who have completed the program and meeting individuals currently enrolled.

“The reason I’m so impressed with Men of Valor is that less than 15% of those who complete the entire one-year program reoffend,” says Mayor Jacobs. “That means less crime, fewer victims, safer communities, and a lot of taxpayer dollars saved.”
