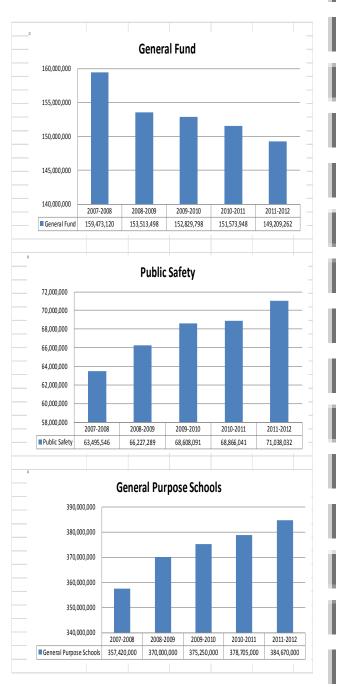

One cent of the property tax rate is estimated to equal \$988,000. Of this tax rate \$0.97 goes to the General Fund, \$1.08 goes to General Purpose School Fund, and \$0.31 goes to General Debt Fund.
