Mayor Jacobs to Speak About Vaccines, Forensic Center and More

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.— During his Weekly Update, which will post about 1:30 p.m. today, Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs speaks about the COVID-19 vaccine eligibility (it's getting expanded); the Knox County Regional Forensic Center's latest achievement (the office once again received full accreditation); and Knoxville Catalyst Sports (they're holding a big event this weekend).
