## Mayor Jacobs Talks Bassmaster, Collier Preserve, CenterPoint, Black History

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.— During his Weekly Update, which will post about 3 p.m. today, Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs talks about the Bassmaster Classic's return, Collier Preserve, and the McNabb Center, which broke ground on their CenterPointe expansion – an alcohol, drug residential rehabilitation, medical detoxication and crisis stabilization unit – on Tuesday.
